Open business and two vehicles struck by gunfire

On Wednesday, January 4, 2023 at 12:54 A.M., officers responded to 348 SW Baya Avenue, Waffle House, to the report of gunfire.

Upon arrival, officers were advised of a vehicle which was possibly involved in the gunfire. The vehicle was stopped and all occupants were cleared of having any involvement in the incident. Two vehicles and the business were struck by and sustained damage from the gunfire which was witnessed by several individuals who could not provide a description of the shooter. One of the vehicles and the business were occupied. No one was injured during the incident.
