Investigation leads to arrest after 10 vehicles burglarized at local dealership

On Thursday, November 3, 2022 at 8:40 A.M., officers from the Lake City Police Department were dispatched to 2588 W US Hwy 90, Rountree Moore Ford, to the report of 10 vehicles being burglarized.

Upon arrival, officers met with an employee who reported 10 vehicles, which were all customer's vehicles, parked in the service area had their interiors pilfered through and items stolen. Each victim was contacted to conduct an inventory of their vehicle. Video footage of the incident was provided by the dealership and still photos of the suspect were uploaded the Lake City Police Department's social media pages asking for citizen's help in identifying the suspect.

Multiple tips were received identifying the suspect as Timothy Ray Warren 7/8/1984.

On January, 23, 2023, Investigators located Warren and conducted an interview with Warren of the incident. After the interview, Warren was arrested and transported to the Columbia County Detention Center without incident. During the search of Warren, incident to his arrest, cocaine was located and an additional charge was added.
