Arrest made for evidence tampering in shooting on N Marion

On Saturday, September 24, 2022, shortly before 1:00 A.M., officers with the Lake City Police Department on a traffic stop were interrupted by the sound of nearby gunfire a few blocks away. Officers responded to the area of 877 N Marion Ave where they found two gunshot victims, one inside a vehicle parked beside a residence and one lying nearby. The subject inside the vehicle was deceased. The other victim was treated on scene and transported to an area hospital.

During the course of the investigation, investigators followed up on leads and interviewed subjects involved. It was determined three armed individuals had approached a residence on N Marion Avenue with intentions of robbing the occupants. Upon attempting to do so, the suspects were met with resistance from one of the occupants of the home who used force to defend themselves.

An individual was notified of the incident before law enforcement's arrival, this individual then went to the residence and removed items of evidentiary value from the home. This led to the arrest of Trabarius Elijah Hogue who was charged with Tampering with Evidence.
