Two shot in separate incidents Friday night

On Friday, February 3, 2023 at 8:59 P.M., officers from the Lake City Police Department were dispatched to W US Hwy 90 at NW Ridgewood Avenue to the report of a person shot.

Upon arrival, officers located a victim suffering from two gunshot wounds. The victim advised they were traveling west on W US Hwy 90 when a grey SUV pulled alongside of their vehicle and began shooting into the vehicle. The victim was the sole occupant of the vehicle and was transported by EMS for their injuries.

On Friday, February 3, 2023 at 10:30 P.M., officers from the Lake City Police Department were dispatched to NE Trinity Place to the report of a person shot.

Upon arrival, officers located two persons inside a home which had been struck by numerous rounds of gunfire. One person inside the home was struck in the back by a bullet fragment. The victim was treated on scene by EMS for their injuries.

Both crime scenes were processed by Investigators from the Lake City Police Department's Criminal Investigation Division with the assistance of Crime Scene Technicians from the Columbia County Sheriff's Office.

None of the injuries in either incident were life threatening.
