Arrest made after one person shot

On Friday, March 3, 2023 at 5:40 P.M., officers from the Lake City Police Department were dispatched to 801 NW Lake Jeffrey Road, Stop N Go, to the report of gunfire.

One victim suffering from a gunshot wound, was transported to a local hospital by private vehicle, and treated for their injuries.

Upon arrival at the scene, officers reviewed the businesses' video surveillance which captured the incident. At the same time, the suspect vehicle was located by an officer. The vehicle was traveling east on NE Martin Luther King Jr. Street. The vehicle's driver failed to stop and continued south on NE Coldwater Avenue. Pursuing officers observed the passenger toss a firearm from the vehicle which was located and collected. The vehicle stopped on NE Coldwater Avenue at the railroad tracks. Both the driver and passenger fled from the vehicle on foot. A perimeter was established with the assistance of deputies from the Columbia County Sheriff's Office. Department of Corrections' K-9 team attempted to track the two but was unsuccessful.

On Saturday, March 4, 2023 the driver, Ike Vanquez Henderson was arrested and transported to the Columbia County Detention Center after turning himself in to officers.
