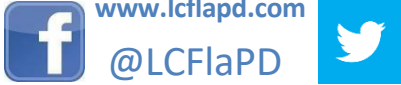

Convicted Felon points firearm at Victim

On March 27, 2023, at 10:24 pm, Lake City Police Department responded to 1415 SW Haygood Loop, for a call for service.

Officers arrived and spoke with the victim who advised a black male, identified as Joseph Webb, pointed a loaded gun at the victim during a verbal disagreement. The victim told officers that Webb left the scene in a red Chevy Caprice.

Officers located the car traveling on Main Street and Baya Drive and conducted a traffic stop. A 9mm handgun was located under the driver's seat of the vehicle.

During the investigation it was discovered Webb had six prior felony convictions.

Webb was transported to the Columbia County Jail and charged with Aggravated Assault and Possession of a Firearm by a Convicted Felon.

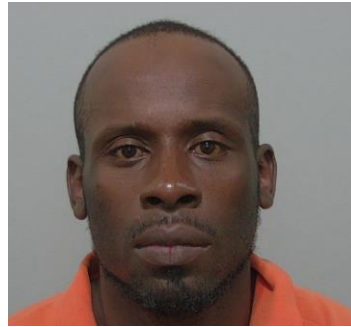
