Altercation leads to gunfire, one arrested

On Friday, June 16, 2023 at 10:11 A. M., officers from the Lake City Police Department were dispatched to NE Martin Luther King Jr. Street to the report of a disturbance involving gunfire.

Upon arrival, officers met with the victim who stated they were in a verbal altercation with Frederick Antonio Dace. During the altercation, Dace displayed a firearm and fired several rounds at the victim. No one was injured during the incident. A search warrant for Dace's property was prepared, approved by an Assistant State's Attorney and signed by a Judge. During the execution of the search warrant, firearms and ammunition were located.

Dace was located, arrested and transported to the Columbia County Detention Center without further incident.
