## **Pratt Arrested**

On Monday, July 10, 2023, after the publication of the press release and wanted flyer, Jaquary D. Pratt turned himself into the Lake City Police Department without incident. The original press release is continued below.

On Friday, July 7, 2023 at approximately 4:25 p.m. officers were dispatched to Cedar Park Apartments in reference to a person shot.

The victim reported they arranged to sell a firearm to Jaquary D. Pratt. Upon their meeting, Pratt arrived with two others, both identified as black males. One of the black males drew a firearm and pointed it at the victim's temple. The victim pushed the firearm away and the firearm discharged, causing a gunshot wound to the victim's lower extremity.

The victim was stable and transported by EMS to a local hospital for treatment.

A warrant has been issued for Mr. Pratt. Mr. Pratt is considered to be armed and dangerous. If observed, do not approach the suspect and call law enforcement immediately.

Officers are still attempting to identify the additional two black males. Report information to 386-752-4344.
