## Robbery of Stop & Go

On Tuesday, July 25, 2023 at 10:30 P.M., officers from the Lake City Police Department were dispatched to 1263 W US Hwy 90, Stop & Go, for a reported robbery.

Upon arrival, officers learned an unknown suspect had robbed the business at gunpoint before fleeing on foot in a northwestern direction.

An employee, who was outside the business, was approached from behind by an unknown person who placed a handgun to the employee's back and ordered them to enter the business. Once inside, the suspect threw a small blue backpack to the cashier and stated "give me all the money." After the cashier had placed the money in the backpack, the suspect ordered both employees to lie on the floor before he took the backpack and fled the business on foot. Both employees described the suspect as a black male, wearing gray shorts, a black shirt, black Nike shoes, a black shower cap and a white surgical mask on his face.

No one was hurt during the incident.
