Traffic stop leads to drug arrests

On Saturday, August 5, 2023 at 5:46 P.M., officers from the Lake City Police Department conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle for a passenger's seatbelt violation.

Upon approaching the driver's window, officers detected the smell of marijuana coming from inside the vehicle. The officer could also plainly see a plastic bag containing a green plant like substance along with a firearm on the passenger floorboard.

The driver, Sabrina Lynn Blackburn, and passenger, Jacob Donovan Harper Barnett, were removed from the vehicle and a probable cause search was conducted. The search revealed several different types of narcotics including THC, cocaine, marijuana, oxycodone, MDMA and Psilocybin.

Both occupants were arrested and transported to the Columbia County Detention Center without further incident.
