Crash investigation leads to DUI arrest

On Monday, January 1, 2024 at 8:37 P.M., officers from the Lake City Police Department were dispatched to the 3800 block of West US Hwy 90 to a traffic accident.

Upon arrival, officers determined Elschanoco E. Jackson was the driver of a vehicle involved in the accident. Jackson was evaluated on scene by EMS and was cleared. After investigating the traffic accident and finding Jackson to be at fault, officers began an investigation into the possibility of Jackson operating a motor vehicle while under the influence.

Officers determined there was probable cause to believe Jackson was under the influence. He was read implied consent and requested to submit a breath, blood or urine sample for the purposes of detecting alcohol or narcotics in his system. Jackson refused and was arrested without incident. He was then transported to the Columbia County Detention Center.
