## Crash leaves one arrested

On Wednesday, January 24, 2024 at 3:35 P. M., officers from the Lake City Police Department were dispatched to S Marion Avenue at the intersection of SE Saint John's Street to the report of a vehicle crash.

Upon arrival, officers provided medical attention to those in need until the arrival of EMS. Officer then conducted the traffic crash investigation during which they determined Raeshaun Tariq Jordan, of Jacksonville, had fled from members of the Multijurisdictional Drug Task Force. Members did not pursue but were close by when Jordan ran a stop sign and was struck by a vehicle having the right of way. Jordan was cited as at fault in the traffic crash and arrested on other charges after the traffic crash investigation.

Jordan was arrested and transported to the Columbia County Detention Center without further incident.
