Two arrested after investigation of gunshot alert

On Sunday, February, 4, 2024 at 11:43 A.M., officers from the Lake City Police Department were dispatched to SE Allen Place to the report of a FLOCK gunshot detection alert.

Upon arrival, officers spoke with a victim who was suffering from a laceration above the eye. The victim further stated that Robbrechia Tracharinee Glo Fulton struck the victim with an eyebrow razor and pulled their hair. Calvin James Souter Jr. also struck the victim in the chest with his fist before firing a handgun into the air, pointing it at the victim, and threatening to shoot them. Fulton and Souter then fled the area in a vehicle.

During the investigation, a shell casing was located, processed and collected.

A description of the vehicle was provided to other area law enforcement agencies. At 4:40 P.M. deputies from the Columbia County Sheriff's Office spotted the suspect's vehicle and conducted a traffic stop during which both Souter and Fulton were taken into custody without further incident.

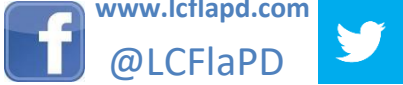
