## Arrest Made After Gunfire Damages Hotel Room

On Wednesday, May 28, 2025, at approximately 2:23 P.M., officers from the Lake City Police Department responded to the Baymont Inn and Suites, located at 3598 W US Highway 90, in reference to a report of property damage caused by gunfire.

Upon arrival, officers met with hotel staff who reported that a guest had checked out earlier that afternoon and was observed walking to his vehicle with a firearm. Housekeeping staff later discovered spent shell casings on the floor, visible bullet holes in the wall, and multiple damaged items in the guest's room.

Officers reviewed surveillance footage showing the individual, later identified as Nicklous Hightower, carrying a rifle and appearing agitated while checking out. Officers entered the room and confirmed multiple bullet holes, spent shell casings, and significant damage estimated at over \$2,000.

Hightower was located while driving to the Columbia County Sheriff's Office Operations Center, where he claimed that snakes had been planted in his vehicle. Officers made contact with Hightower, who waived his Miranda rights and stated that he had discharged his firearm at perceived threats inside his hotel room. A consensual search of his vehicle revealed ammunition and a loaded AR-15-style rifle, both of which were collected and placed into evidence.

Hightower was arrested and transported to the Columbia County Detention Center without incident.

"This case underscores the importance of quickly reporting suspicious behavior," stated Chief of Police Gerald Butler. "Thanks to the swift action of hotel staff and responding officers, no one was harmed, and a potentially dangerous situation was safely resolved."
