Felon Arrested After Gun Disturbance at KFC

On Tuesday, July 15, 2025, at approximately 4:54 p.m., officers from the Lake City Police Department were dispatched to Kentucky Fried Chicken (KFC), located at 313 SW Baya Drive, in reference to a disturbance involving a gun. Dispatch advised officers that the suspect had fled the scene and provided a description: a Black male wearing a white shirt and gray shorts, with multiple tattoos, and carrying a small bag or pouch.

Responding officers observed a suspect matching the description running from the area and stopped him at McDonald's, 491 SW Main Boulevard. The individual, identified as Trevis Johnson, was compliant with officers' orders. He was no longer in possession of the bag when searched by officers.

A canvas of the surrounding area was conducted, and the bag was located. Inside was a loaded silver Raven Arms MP25 handgun.

Johnson has two prior felony convictions for armed robbery with a deadly weapon.

Johnson was arrested and charged with possession of a firearm by a convicted felon. He was transported to the Columbia County Detention Center without further incident.
